Please bring your family—kids, spouses, and older grandchildren are welcome.

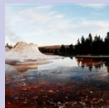

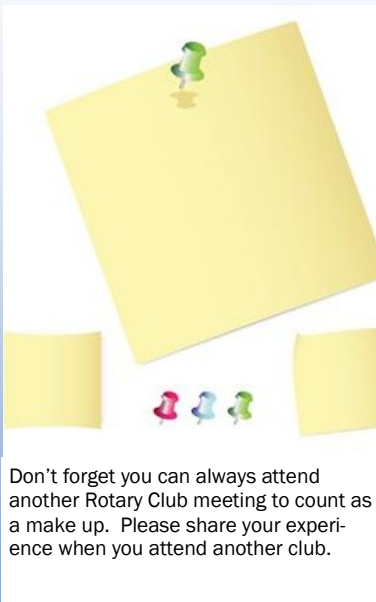
