

Redmond Rotary Club

Application and Admission to Redmond Rotary

1. Sponsor brings prospective member to Rotary as a “guest” up to three times. Sponsor pays for the “guests” meal.
2. If prospective member is interested in joining Rotary, prospective member and sponsor meet with a Membership Committee member. Membership Committee member gives prospective member an Introduction Packet and interviews prospective member.
3. If prospective member is interested in joining, membership committee member takes an application from the prospective member.
4. Membership Committee member proposes prospective member to the Rotary board of directors.
5. Board votes to either approve or decline proposal.
6. If approved, president reads prospective member’s name to the club two times as a “prospective member”. Rotary pays for up to two prospective member’s meals during the readings.
7. If no objections to prospective member joining, prospective member submits a fee of \$200 prior to Induction. Fee is to be collected by Membership Committee member.
8. Membership Committee Chairman orders a red badge for the new member. (Ordered by Membership Chair)
9. Original application goes to club’s Secretary. A copy of application along with the admission fee is given to the club’s Treasurer.

10. New member is inducted with spouse and Sponsor on the 4th Thursday of the new month.
 - a. New member is provided with an Induction Packet
 - b. Sponsor introduces the new Rotarian and spouse to club.
 - c. Sponsor should also prepare a brief biography of the new member and give it as part of the Induction to the club.
 - d. Sponsor pins new member and provides them with a red name badge

11. Sponsor follow-up during the first year:
 - a. Help new member get acquainted with other members.
 - b. Help new member to move from red badge to blue badge.
 - c. Arrange to bring new member to meetings or meet them there.
 - d. Take new member to make up at another club or board meeting for their first time.
 - e. Take new member to their first Fireside.
 - f. Invite new member to participate in fund raising and service projects.
