### Guinness World Record Attempt

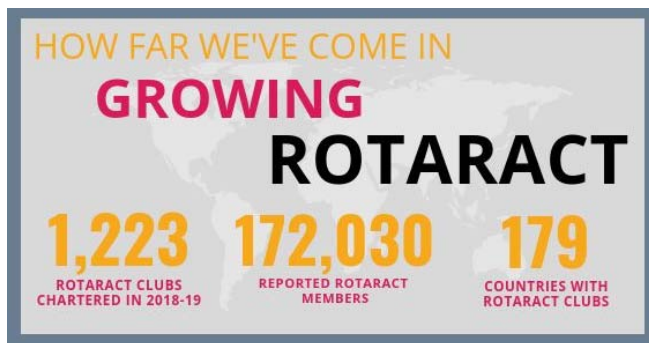
Thats right! We have been approved by the Guinness Book of World Records for our food relief food packing event at this year's District 5030 Conference in Seattle (April 2020).

### District Project - Music 4 Life



#### Total Instruments Delivered

Since September 1st, *Music4Life* has provided 333 donated and repaired full-sized musical instruments to our nine public school districts for use by students in need, breaking last year's record year of 311 instruments. An additional 1,788 recorders have been provided for use by third- and fourth-graders in Highline and Everett Schools for use in our Link Up program with the Seattle Symphony Orchestra at Benaroya Hall. This brings the total value of instruments provided this year to \$156,821 with more than a month to go. All instrument values are according to our independent third-party experts.
