We Are Meeting At In The MPR At Pacific University Week!

February 7, 2018

Peace Village

On Wed Dec 27 we had a joint meeting with the Daybreak Club. Many members were vacationing so here is a retake on the program. I was "inspired" to share about the nonprofit Peace Village Global, a four day summer camp for children grades 3-8. The program was presented by the director, Wintry Whitt Smith, who is a graduate of Pacific University with a degree in Peace and Conflict studies. She has been involved with Peace Village since its inception in Lincoln City in 1996. The program has four main tracts that focus on conflict resolution, mindfulness, connection to nature and media literacy. These concepts include learning how to listen, sharing of stories, learning compassion and making positive choices.

Stephanie Hogan reported in the lead article of the Jan 24 "News-Times" her observation of a one day concentrated workshop at the Community School. I was there for half of the day and Susan Winterbourne was there from the Daybreak Club.

Peace Village was started in 1996 in Lincoln City and Wintry has been involved since its inception. Pacific University has provided many student counselors for the camps over the years. There are a total of 27 "Peace Village" camps mostly in Oregon with one in Kenya. The curriculum is available for \$500 for the first year and the annual re-licensing fee is \$100. The budget for a group of 50 students figures out to be \$6300 or \$125 per student. To sponsor say 30 scholarships at \$100 would be \$3000 (split between our two clubs and other collaborating entities) would be a commendable service project. The FG Foundation Board has responded favorably, subject to details involved. The McMinnville Sunrise Club sponsored their first Peace Village last Aug.
