**Rotary Club of Joplin
Community Fund Grant Policies, Guidelines, and Limitations**

- Project must address an educational or humanitarian need of our community
- Organization must provide the Rotary Club of Joplin with a written report of the successful completion of the project within 30 days of completion
- Not involve the establishment of a permanent foundation, trust, permanent interest-bearing account
- Not be used to reimburse organizations for projects already undertaken and in progress, and existing project, or projects already completed
- Funds cannot be used for the purchase of land and buildings or for construction of any structure in which individuals live or work; the only exception to the above guidelines is the funding of low cost shelters for extremely underprivileged families
- Grant funds cannot be used for the operating or administrative expense of any organization or for salaries, stipends, or honorariums for individuals working for the organization
- The Rotary Club of Joplin will give special consideration to organizations that have not previously received a Community Fund grant
- The Rotary Club of Joplin intends to grant a total of approximately \$12,000 in Community Fund grants each Rotary year (July 1-June 30)
