Strengthening Club Performance

Complete all the following:

- Participation in AG meetings (at minimum 75% attendance) as requested (by President/PE or any member) monitored by Area Governors.
- Club President-Elect or designee attends Pre-PETS in February 2019
- Club President-Elect or designee attends PETS in March 2019 (PETS for another District can be substituted)
- Any club member becomes a new Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI) Graduate or three other members attend one of the RLI scheduled sessions. District reimburses 50% of registration costs up to 3 members attending. (go to www.rli33.org to register)
- Enter at least three goals in Rotary Club Central (specifically Membership, Foundation and Polio) for Rotary year 2018-19
- Achieve a minimum average member attendance level of 60% at regularly scheduled club meetings conducted during the reporting period.

Complete two of the following:

- Participate in the District Leadership Assembly
- Develop or update club's Strategic Plan
- Evidence of an active recruiting and retention campaign to maintain membership levels (no loss) from starting number at the onset of the Rotary year.
- Implement or utilize new member orientation process

Complete a minimum of one meeting each on 3 different topics

- Membership and New Club Development
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- Water and Sanitation
- Maternal and Child Health
- Rotary Fellowships

Developing Friendships with Rotarians Outside the Club

Complete at least two of the following four:

- At least one club member attends the District Governor Installation Dinner
- At least one club member participates in the Membership Seminar on August 11, 2018 and the Foundation Seminar on September 8, 2018

- At least one club member participates in the District Conference
- At least one club member attends the Rotary International Convention in Toronto Canada 2017-18 or Hamburg Germany in 2018-19

Supporting Rotary's Charity

Complete the following:

- At least one club member becomes a member of the Paul Harris Society or three or more club members become first-time Paul Harris Fellows or Multiple Paul Harris Fellow

Complete any one of the following

- Participate in a District Grant
- Participate in a Global Grant
- At least one club member attends the Foundation Banquet, November 3, 2018

Extending Vocational Diversity

Complete the following:

- Conduct at least five club programs in which members or guests discuss their vocations and ethical standards

Complete one of the following two:

- Recognize one or more community members who have made outstanding professional achievements while maintaining high ethical standards
- Sponsor a day for Rotarians to bring young people to their place of business to learn about their occupations. (consider including local Interact or Rotaract Club members)

Connecting with Youth and Prospective Future Rotarians

Complete the following:

- Conduct a club program with Interact, Rotaract or Youth Exchange students

Complete any of the following:

- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Inbound Youth Exchange student (from outside USA)
- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Outbound Youth Exchange student (from this District to an Overseas District)
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a college-based or community-based Rotaract Club.
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a student to the District's Rotary youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)
- Sponsor at least one student to participate in the Rotarians Against Drug (RAD) speech contest. (Consider including local Interact Club members)

Community Service

Complete the following:

- 10% club participation (based on membership) in District-wide service project

Complete two of the three

- At least 50% engagement of club members in club project-hands on project
- Joining with another club in community project, i.e. dictionary project with at least 25% of membership involved
- Promote club's involvement of service project using media outlets, newspaper, social media or on-line publications. (supporting documentation needs to be submitted)
